The Namibia University of Science and Technology is proud to implement the P³ICL project Protecting, Preserving and Promoting Indigenous Languages and Culture funded by the European Union with an approximate grant of N\$ 3,750,000 (€ 250,000). P³ICL aims to focus on endangered dialects among the Owambo, Ovaherero and Khoe-khoe indigenous groups producing a repository of cultural expressions like proverbs, folk-tales and other scientific and non-scientific awareness raising products with the view to influencing national policies in its quest for promoting cultural unity in diversity in Namibia over 3 years together with the Ministry of Basic Education, Arts and Culture and its designated departments and UNESCO.
